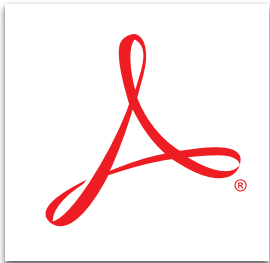


Sanitization—Remove hidden data from PDF files with Adobe® Acrobat® XI



With a single click, find and delete all hidden data in a PDF file, including text, metadata, annotations, form fields, attachments, and bookmarks.

1. At the top right in Acrobat, click the Tools pane. Open the Protection panel.
2. The sanitation tools are listed under the heading Hidden Information.
 - To permanently remove items such as metadata, comments, and file attachments, select Sanitize Document. Click OK.
 - To have more control over what is removed, select Remove Hidden Information.
3. Type a name for your file, and click Save.
